

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST - JUDO

Event Outline

The Virtus Global Games is being held in Vichy, France **4 – 10 June 2023**. Sport Inclusion Australia is working in conjunction with the relevant National Sporting Organisations to coordinate the Australian Team. This event will feature 11 different sports (Athletics, Basketball, Cycling, Equestrian, Futsal, Judo, Rowing, Swimming, Table Tennis, Taekwondo, and Tennis).

1 June	team departs for Vichy, France
2 June	team arrives in Vichy, France
4 June	Opening Ceremony
5-9 June	Athletics competition
10 June	Closing Ceremony
11 June	Team departs

Eligibility

Costs

By submitting your Expression of Interest you are agreeing to cover costs of your participation as outlined below.

The cost for athletes will be \$6,900 – 7,900 (depending on final details), this includes:

- Uniform
- Flights from capital cities
- All Meals
- Virtus Levy
- Ground transport in Vichy
- Accommodation
- Insurance
- Entry Fees
- Staff and Administration contribution

SIA will be working hard to access external funding to reduce this amount. Competition uniforms are in addition to the above. Flights will be arranged from Brisbane, Sydney, Canberra, Melbourne, Hobart, Adelaide, Perth and Darwin. Any additional flights/travel will need to be organised by the athlete. Athletes will need some spending money for snacks, merchandise and some sightseeing. All other costs whilst in France are covered by the Games organisers.

SELECTION CRITERIA - JUDO

BELT REQUIREMENT

Mainstream Green Belt - 24 Throws + first set of the Kata + 6 holds + 2 arm locks + 2 strangles + 2 counters + 2 combinations.

OR

No Limits Blue Brown Belt - 13 Throws + first set of the Kata + 10 holds + 3 combinations + demonstrated knowledge of 2 counters + 2 armbars and 2 strangles.

COMPETITION EXPERIENCE:

Must have either Oceania or National or International experience in Tachi Waza in Judo Australia sanctioned Competition.
